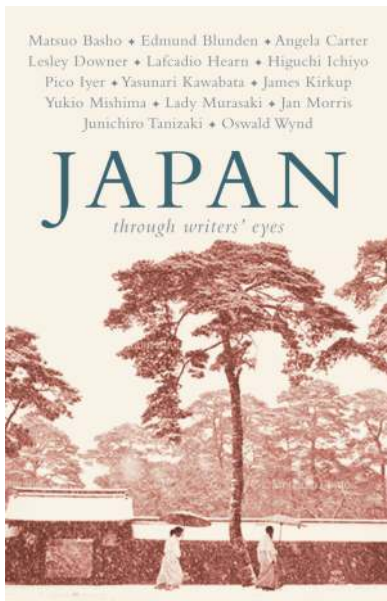


Japan Through Writers' Eyes

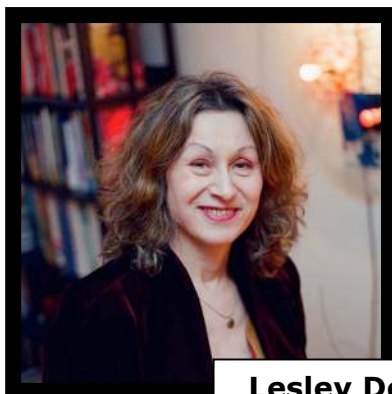
